Definition

- **Non-Medical Therapies** include equine therapy, music therapy, dance therapy, art therapy, and specialized recreation therapy. Non-Medical Therapies may provide individuals with opportunities to enhance social skills development through the development of relationships in the community and provide opportunities to practice social skills.

Assessment Checklist

- The NLACRC program planning team has determined that a non-medical therapy that can address social skill challenges, and such challenges, are documented in the consumer's record.
- An opportunity has been identified to achieve an improvement in the consumer's social, recreational, or leisure life in the community or to develop relationships.
- The determination shall be made based on the needs and preferences of the individual, or when appropriate, the individual's family, and shall include a range of service options proposed by the program planning team
- Identify services that will be effective, and of those services identified, the team will select the most cost-effective option for inclusion.
- Must consider generic, public, and private resources that will be effective in assisting the individual in achieving the IPP outcome prior to expending regional center funds.
- Review current services and supports in place that include socialization, leisure, and recreation and discuss how those goals/objectives will support additional opportunities in the community.
