

# EVACUACIONES DURANTE UN INCENDIO FORESTAL

*Mantengase consciente de su entorno.  
Váyase cuando le pidan las autoridades locales.*

## Tome Acción Inmediatamente

Váyase tan pronto una evacuación es recomendada por autoridades para evitar ser atrapado en el incendio, humo o congestión de tráfico. Un retraso podría costarle la vida!

Tome la iniciativa para mantenerse informado. Preste a anuncios de la policía o manejo de emitidos en la radio, TV, o alertas en su celular

Cúbrase para protegerse del calor y ceniza en el aire.

Use pantalones largos, camisas con mangas largas, zapatos cerrados/botas, gorra, mascarilla, gafas.

Asegúrese de tener un kit de emergencia en su vehículo.

Ponga en pie su plan de evacuación que incluye la ruta que usted tomara y tenga un lugar para encontrarse fuera del incendio o área peligro

# EVACUATING FROM WILDFIRES

*Always stay aware of your environment.  
Leave when asked by your local emergency officials.*

## TAKE ACTION IMMEDIATELY

Leave as soon as evacuation is recommended by fire officials to avoid being caught in fire, smoke or road congestion. A delay could cost your life!

Take the initiative to stay informed and aware. Listen to your radio, TV, or alerts on your phone for announcements from law enforcement and emergency personnel.



Cover up to protect against heat and flying embers. Wear long pants, long sleeve shirt, heavy shoes/boots, cap, a face mask, goggles or glasses.



Ensure your emergency supply kit is in your vehicle.



Enact your evacuation plan that includes the route you'll take and designated emergency meeting location outside the fire or hazard area.
